- 1 Chenin Blanc, Lion Ridge**  
*Western Cape, South Africa*  
This fruity, medium style white leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. (3) 13% vol

- 2 Sauvignon Blanc, Estampilla de Genio**  
*Central Valley, Chile*  
Straightforward and easy drinking with plenty of ripe fruits. (1) 12.5% vol

- 3 Garganega-Pinot Grigio, Tanti Petali, Botter**  
*Veneto, Italy*

*Piemonte, Italy*  
Brilliantly bright and fresh with charming poached pear and peach fruit flavours. Zesty acidity with a hint of minerality on the finish. (2) 13% vol

*Hawkes Bay, New Zealand*  
Understated, yet full and quietly grand. It makes a very good all-purpose wine with freshness, broad fruit style and good weight well combined. (2) 13% vol

*Loire, France*  
Classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. (1) 12.5% vol

*Burgundy, France*  
A rich and complex wine with a wonderful, fat structure in the mouth and the charming typical Chardonnay aromas of butter or brioche. Harmonious, fine and elegant with an excellent aromatic linger. (1) 12.5% vol

- 11 Merlot, Estampilla de Genio**  
*Central Valley, Chile*  
Easy drinking, soft and plummy with a smooth finish. (C) 13% vol

- 12 Shiraz, Billycan**  
*South East Australia*  
Here's a juicy fruity Aussie red with balanced alcohol to give a deliciously easy drinking Shiraz. It's time to rediscover just how good the wines from Down Under are tasting. (B) 13.5% vol

- 13 Rioja, Cormoran**  
*Rioja, Spain*

- 14 Cabernet Sauvignon, Urmeneta**  
*Central Valley, Chile*  
Dark, ruby colour, full of red fruit aromas, perfectly mixed with sweet vanilla and coconut notes. It has a fresh mouthfeel, medium body, soft tannins and a long, pleasant finish. (C) 13.5% vol

- 15 Malbec, Tamari**  
*Mendoza, Argentina*  
Soft red fruit notes with elegantly smooth tannins and a lingering finish. A great example of Argentina's hallmark red wine. (C) 12.5% vol

- 16 Pinot Noir, Rue des Amis**  
*Languedoc, France*  
Exceptionally smooth with soft tannins, red fruit aromas and cherry flavours. A lighter red and very food friendly. (B) 12.5% vol

- 17 Merlot, Wandering Bear**  
*California, USA*  
Plummy red fruit with a sweet herbal note. Sumptuous and full of plum, cherry and vanilla flavours. (B) 13% vol

- 18 Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva, Tor del Colle, Botter**  
*Abruzzo, Italy*  
Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. (C) 13.5% vol

- 19 Beaujolais, Terra Iconia**  
*Burgundy, France*  
An abundance of intense berry fruits such as redcurrant, blackberry and blueberry. A subtle, floral peony fragrance lingers on the palate and combines with mineral notes and round, silky tannins to give a balanced glass with a lengthy, fruity finish. (A) 12.5% vol

- 20 Ermita de San Felices Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Santalba**  
*Rioja, Spain*  
Intensely concentrated with blackberry fruit and wonderful enriching sweetness. Beginning to show meaty, gamey, leathery development with a finish that lasts forever. Fabulous! (D) 14% vol

*Italy*  
Very light and refreshing with a delicate pear-drop fruit. Absolutely bright and fresh, terrifically easy to drink. (1) 12% vol
